



Business development lead - voluntary role

Introduction

Age in Spain is a small, modern and dynamic national charity of skilled and committed volunteers which provides trusted, accurate information for English speakers living in or moving to Spain and one to one help for older people and their carers to access the right services and support and maintain independence.

We receive no government funding and completely rely on donations to fund our work. To meet this challenge in 2024, we are establishing a new volunteer team of creative, skilled people to help deliver our income generation plans. The Business Development Lead is a strategic player in establishing and developing this team.

Role Summary

To help Age in Spain commercialise and optimise opportunities to raise needed funds through sponsorships, grants, donations, and fundraising activities and events. To do so in a collaborative manner as part of the charity's leadership team - the duties are complex and it is not expected that the incumbent will complete all tasks and create all content. Their team-mates will contribute to and support all activities.

Reporting directly to the Chief Executive, you will be expected to:

- Develop and gain sign off to a fundraising strategy
- Energise volunteers to become a community of commercially savvy, fund-raising champions
- Build and maintain professional relations both internally and externally
- Research and identify opportunities for sponsorship and commercialisation of services, and pursue through to completion
- Research and identify commercial and other partnerships for collaborative benefit, and pursue through to completion
- Develop a programme of virtual and in-person events to generate funds eg auctions, raffles, sponsored activities, social gatherings etc
- Commercialise the 'Moving to Spain' guide determining the optimum pricing and route to market, followed by a series of other appropriate guides for commercialisation

- Identify and pursue grant-making bodies eg foundations, EU, etc
- Help prepare financial documentation for the completion of fund-raising applications
- Ensure volunteers, donors and funders are kept informed of how the money is spent, and the positive outcomes that ensue
